








RETAL has continued to work towards reaching its near-term SBT in line with a 1.5°C trajectory for the reduction of its



RETAL endeavours to provide optimal working conditions which ensures safety, well-being and occupational satisfaction to its employees to enable them to perform and develop to the best of their ability.

RETAL checks its performance and identifies improvement opportunities via an annual employee survey and has set targets (65% score by 2030) for three working condition KPIs, which provide a comprehensive view of the employees' experience: Work Engagement, Job Satisfaction and Empowerment.

OHS is a key material topic for RETAL, which provides the necessary resources to ensure proper management to minimize accident risks and subsequent impact.

Ethics & supply chain


RETAL aims to operate and act ethically, with integrity and responsibility in everything it does, and expects the same from its employees and business partners.
